Dear Vice Mayor Whittum,

I just wanted to make sure you and your constituents were aware of the Winter Gas Savings Program from PG&E. Gas customers can earn a 20 percent bill credit by conserving energy now. To help you stay on track with your conservation effort and earn the credit, PG&E has created an easy to use tracker available on the PG&E website and on Facebook.

This first-of-its-kind application allows residential and business customers with gas SmartMeters™ to check their use against the savings target and track to see their current status in qualifying for a bill credit. To check your tracker status, you will need your account number to login, so have a past bill handy and enter the first 10 numbers of the account.

The Winter Gas Savings program rewards customers for conserving gas during the peak demand months of December and January. With Winter Gas Savings, customers can save two ways. First, you can save on your monthly gas costs. Second, you can earn a bonus credit of up to 20 percent on your PG&E bill.

Earning the credit is easier than you might think by taking simple steps you can make a big impact. An example is you can save as much as 5 percent on heating costs by lowering your thermostat by 1° F (if it's set between 60° and 70° F).

Customers who conserve up to 10 percent will receive an equal percentage credit on their February or March gas bills. Customers who conserve 10 percent or more will receive a 20 percent credit.
